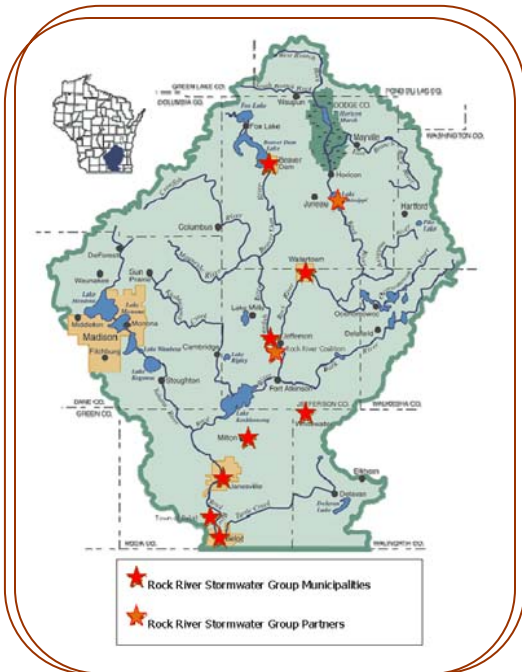


The Rock River Stormwater Group

Cities in the Rock River Basin have created the Rock River Stormwater Group (RRSG), to develop and operate a Stormwater Education Program to fulfill the WDNR Municipal Separated Storm Sewer, or MS4 permit requirements and to promote sustainable stormwater practices in the Rock River Basin.

The cities of Beaver Dam, Beloit, Fort Atkinson, Janesville, Milton, Watertown and Whitewater, as well as the Town of Beloit and the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater are Full Members with dues of \$5,000 or \$2,000 depending on size.

Other memberships include Associate Members are all other municipalities whose fee is \$1,000 and Partners who are any organization interested in promoting water quality by helping implement the stormwater education and outreach program.

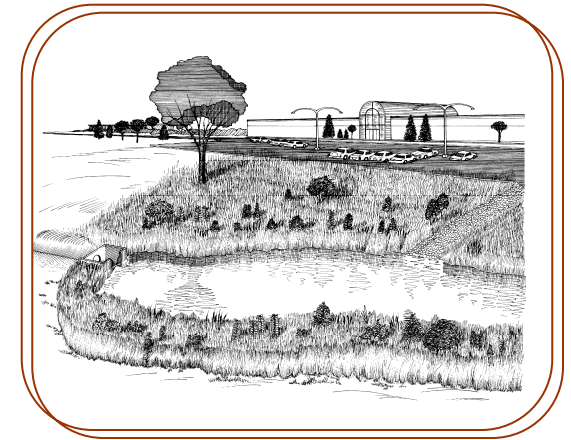

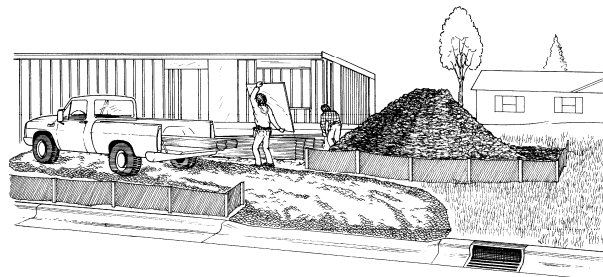
