

**RESOLUTION FORM TO BE MODIFIED TO MEET EACH MUNICIPALITIES
NEEDS**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN
INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR THE CREATION AND OPERATION
OF A STORMWATER EDUCATION PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the **CITY, VILLAGE, ETC** to create a Stormwater Education Program to fulfill the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources MS4 Permit requirements to help promote sustainable stormwater practices in the Rock River Basin; and

WHEREAS, the MS4 Permit requires the creation of a public outreach and education program, and

WHEREAS, educating, encouraging, and motivating individuals to adopt sustainable storm water practices is necessary to promote better water quality and to fulfill obligations of the MS4 Permit, and

WHEREAS, by entering into a Rock River Stormwater Group members could achieve new efficiencies through regionally coordinating public outreach and education programs, and

WHEREAS, Section 66.0301(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes authorizes cooperation between municipalities, and allows municipalities to contract with each other for the receipt or furnishing of services or the joint exercise of any power or duty required or authorized by law, and

WHEREAS, the Rock River Stormwater Group would provide materials, reports and an education program sufficient to fulfill the public education and outreach requirements of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Municipal Storm Sewer System General Permit, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the **CITY, VILLAGE, ETC.** to join the Rock River Stormwater Group and enter into the Rock River Stormwater agreement.

Now, therefore, **BE IT RESOLVED**, that the CITY, VILLAGE, ETC. e.g. Common Council authorizes and directs that the CITY, VILLAGE, ETC. become a full member of the Rock River Stormwater Group, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the CITY, VILLAGE, ETC. is authorized to pay from the e.g. Stormwater Utility Fund the \$5,000.00 membership fee to join the Rock River Stormwater Group, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the e.g. Public Works Director, or his designee, shall be designated as the CITY, VILLAGE, ETC.'s official representative to the Rock River Stormwater Group, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the GOVERNING BODY OF CITY, VILLAGE, ETC. authorizes and directs that the CITY, VILLAGE, ETC. enter into the attached Rock River Stormwater Group Agreement relating to the creation and sustainment of the Rock River Stormwater Group.
